Parks & Recreation Online Registration Shuts Down for 24 Hours to Upgrade Software *Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center Waives Fees for the Day*

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Oct. 31, 2017 – The Calvert County Department of Parks & Recreation announces it will be performing an upgrade to its online registration software “RecTrac” this weekend Nov. 5-6, 2017. During the upgrade, the public will not be able to register or perform any type of credit card transaction for Parks & Recreation programs online or in person.

The upgrade will begin Sunday, Nov. 5 at 8 p.m. and may take up to 48 hours. All Calvert County Parks & Recreation facilities will be open for normal operating hours and are able to accept cash/check/money order payments during the upgrade, with the exception of the Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center. Instead, on Monday, Nov. 6, the aquatic center will hold a Customer Appreciation Day and waive all admission fees for the community.

“Please take advantage of using this great facility and accept our thanks for your patience for the disruption during our upgrade,” said Parks & Recreation Director Shannon Nazzal. Online registration availability is expected to resume Tuesday morning.
