## **Four Public Hearings Scheduled for February**

**PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Jan. 26, 2018** – The Calvert County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) will hold four public hearings Feb. 6, 2018, to consider and receive comments on amendments to the Calvert County Sheriff's Office Pension Plan Trust Agreement, the Employees Retirement Plan Trust Agreement, the Employees Retirement Savings Plan Trust Agreement and the Employees Retirement Savings Plan. The hearings will begin at 10:30 a.m. at the Commissioners Hearing Room in the Calvert County Circuit Courthouse, located at 175 Main St. in Prince Frederick.

Citizens are encouraged to attend public hearings and comment on various issues and proposals being decided by the BOCC. Public hearing notices are published in a local newspaper two weeks prior to the date of a hearing.
