### **Public Hearing on Grinder Pump Fees to Be Held June 19, 2018**

**PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – June 11, 2018** – The Calvert County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) will hold a public hearing Tuesday, June 19, 2018, to consider and receive comments on a proposal to establish an annual fee to maintain up to 182 privately owned grinder pumps. The hearing will begin at 10:30 a.m. in the Commissioner’s Hearing Room at the Calvert County Circuit Courthouse, located at 175 Main St. in Prince Frederick.

The proposed \$180 annual fee will apply to residents who own grinder pumps maintained by the Calvert County Department of Public Works Water and Sewerage Division.
