PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – June 27, 2018 – The Maryland Association of Senior Centers (MASC) recognized the Calvert County Office on Aging for outstanding programs and services offered at senior centers. The Office on Aging’s steadfast dedication to serving the aging community in Calvert County led to four awards announced at the MASC statewide meeting held June 14 in Clarksville, Maryland.

The Southern Pines Senior Center received two first-place awards in the nutrition and health promotion and community partnership categories. The awards were for the *Mental Gymnastics* program and the *Meet the Women of the Book: Inspiring African American Women of Calvert County* presentation.

The North Beach Senior Center received a first-place award in the fitness program category and honorable mention in the nutrition and health promotion category. The awards were for the *Increase Your Hold* program and the *Elevator & Escalator Safety* presentation.
