### **Office on Aging to Host 2020 Census Presentations at Calvert County Senior Centers**

**PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Sept. 30, 2019** – As the 2020 Census approaches, older adults may find themselves with questions, concerns or the curiosity to know more about the decennial population count. The Calvert County Office on Aging will host a presentation by U.S. Census Bureau Partnership Specialist Lee Osberry Jr. to discuss the 2020 Census and answer questions older citizens may have about the census, including privacy concerns, how to complete census forms, how census data is used, why participation matters and more.
