Calvert County Announces Columbus Day Schedule

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Oct. 5, 2020 – The Calvert County Board of County Commissioners announces county offices will be closed Monday, Oct. 12, 2020, in observance of Columbus Day. In addition:

- Meals on Wheels will not be delivered Monday, Oct. 12. Weekly meals will be delivered on Tuesday, Oct. 13 following the holiday. Requests for meal delivery can be made through the Office on Aging at 410-535-4606 or OOAmailbox@calvertcountymd.gov.
- There will be no county bus service Monday, Oct. 12.
- The Appeal Landfill and customer convenience centers will be open Monday, Oct. 12 with normal operating hours.
- The Solomons Septage Receiving Facility will be open Monday, Oct. 12 from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- The Water & Sewerage billing and customer service office will be closed Monday, Oct. 12. On-call crews will be available for water and sewer service emergencies only at 410-535-3491.
- Chesapeake Hills Golf Course will be open with normal hours. Modified policies and procedures for golfers and staff have been implemented to comply with distancing requirements and protective guidelines to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. The course is open to all users.
- Kings Landing Park will be open Monday, Oct. 12 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Entrance gate closes at 4:30 p.m.
- Flag Ponds Nature Park will be open to Calvert County residents only Monday, Oct. 12 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Entrance gate closes at 3:30 p.m.

- Battle Creek Cypress Swamp will be open Monday, Oct. 12 from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with limited trail use. Visitors are advised to be aware of their surroundings due to a modified trail system as storm repairs are underway. The nature center remains closed to the public. Entrance gate closes at 4 p.m.
- The Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center will be open Saturday, Oct. 10 from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m., Sunday, Oct. 11 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Monday, Oct. 12 from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Swim sessions are available by online reservation only. In an effort to slow the spread COVID-19, all swimmers must maintain adequate physical distancing at all times and wear a mask when not in the water. Guests will have their temperature checked and must sign a waiver upon entrance to the facility. Shower and locker facilities will not be available for use.
- All recreation parks including Dunkirk, Hallowing Point, Cove Point and Solomons Town Center parks will be open with normal operating hours through the holiday weekend.
- Breezy Point Beach & Campground will be open to Calvert County residents only Friday, Oct. 9 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday, Oct. 10 through Monday, Oct. 12 from 8 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- The Linda L. Kelley Animal Shelter and Animal Control Division will be closed Monday, Oct. 12. The shelter will reopen Tuesday, Oct. 13 by appointment only.
- Calvert Library locations will be closed Monday, Oct. 12. Online services will be available during this time. All locations will be open Tuesday, Oct. 13 from noon to 5 p.m. for limited service. Curbside pickup will be available 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- The Calvert Marine Museum and Museum Store will be open at limited capacity with social distancing guidelines in place. Face coverings are required. Visit www.CalvertMarineMuseum.org to learn more.
