Hallowing Point Park Master Plan Update Public Hearing Scheduled May 21

Prince Frederick, Md. – May 7, 2025 – The Calvert County Department of Parks & Recreation announces the Hallowing Point Park Master Plan Update will be presented to the Planning Commission on May 21 at 7 p.m. to receive public input on proposed updates. The hearing will be held in person at the Harriet E. Brown Community Center, located at 901 Dares Beach Road in Prince Frederick.

The proposed plan includes enhancements to park amenities such as improving and expanding paved walking paths, creating new natural surface trails, converting several multi-use grass fields to synthetic turf, upgrading baseball and softball fields, improving signage and constructing a new inground skatepark, among other improvements.
