Portion of Armory Road in Prince Frederick to Close for Phase I of Improvement Project

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – June 21, 2013 –Armory Road at the Dares Beach Road intersection in Prince Frederick will close to through traffic on or about Wednesday, June 26, for the first phase of the Armory Road/Chesapeake Boulevard improvement project.

Access to businesses on Armory Road will remain open from Steeple Chase Drive. Portable message boards will be located on the Dares Beach Road approaches to the intersection and road closure notice signs have been placed on Armory Road. This phase is expected to last about four months.

The four-phase project will result in Armory Road improvements including wider shoulders, sidewalks, pedestrian lighting and more. The road's name will change to Chesapeake Boulevard and a traffic circle will be installed at its intersection with Dares Beach Road. The project is part of the larger Prince Frederick loop road and is expected to take 18 to 24 months to complete.
