Due to Winter Storm

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Jan. 21, 2014 – Calvert County government offices closed at noon, Tuesday, Jan. 21, due to the onset of the winter storm. The following Calvert County services have been affected:

- All Calvert County government offices closed at noon.
- County bus service stopped operations at noon Tuesday.
- All county Parks and Recreation activities have been canceled for the evening. Community centers, county parks and the Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center closed at noon Tuesday.
- County convenience centers and the landfill closed at noon.
- Calvert County libraries closed at noon Tuesday.

In the event of prolonged power outages, the county will set up warming centers or shelters. Schedules and locations for these centers will be released if necessary.
