### **Public Input Sought on Proposed Amendments to Huntingtown Master Plan, Zoning Ordinance**

**PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – March 21, 2014** – The Calvert County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) and the Calvert County Planning Commission are seeking public comment on proposed amendments to the Huntingtown Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance. Two upcoming events will give residents opportunities to learn more and offer input.

An informational meeting Wednesday, March 26, 7 p.m., at Huntingtown High School will offer details on the proposed amendments. The BOCC and the Planning Commission will then hold a joint public hearing on the amendments Tuesday, April 1, 7 p.m., also at Huntingtown High School, where official public comment will be solicited.

Proposed Huntingtown Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance changes could modify the extent and location of the wooded buffer along the town center's eastern boundary, setbacks from roads, and setbacks for principal structures and accessory structures. At the March 26 informational meeting, county staff will present the amendment options and be available to answer questions. Oral comments for the official public record may only be provided at the April 1 public hearing.
