Mt. Harmony Road to be Partially Closed for Resurfacing Project *Two-Week Safety Improvement Effort Involves Detours in Owings*

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – July 3, 2014 – A portion of Mt. Harmony Road in Owings will be closed to through traffic for approximately two weeks beginning on or about Monday, July 14, as a segment of the road is resurfaced.

Nearly 700 feet of the roadway between Valley View Court and Rue Court will be improved by repaving and the replacement of guardrails. The \$140,000 project will improve safety through the curved segment of the roadway.

During the project, access to residences on Mt. Harmony Road will not be affected though delays can be expected. Detour routes will be established for motorists traveling along the east/west axis in the Owings area.
