Calvert County Holds Ribbon Cutting for Grand Opening of Expanded Mt. Hope Convenience Center

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – July 11, 2017 – The Calvert County Board of County Commissioners and the Calvert County Department of Public Works will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the Mt. Hope Convenience Center Tuesday, July 18 at 4 p.m. The new center provides one-stop customer service for northern Calvert County’s growing recycling and trash needs seven days a week.

“The new convenience center site was designed and constructed to provide one-way traffic flow when disposing of solid waste and recycling materials by offering greater container capacity, improved traffic patterns, improved customer-friendly amenities and convenient parking on a spacious lot,” explained Department of Public Works Director Rai Sharma. “We are glad to provide citizens quicker and more convenient service without the long traffic lines.”

One of seven county convenience centers, the Mt.
