SPECIAL CLASS "C" ONE DAY LICENSE APPLICATION

In applying for this Special Class "C" One Day Alcoholic Beverage License it is important that the applicant realize his/her responsibility associated with the issuance of the license. The applicant, on behalf of the sponsoring organization using this license as authorized under Section 7-101, et seq. of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland is required to assure compliance with State law and the Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County's Rules and Regulations relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages. The applicant and the sponsoring organization will comply with the following conditions for the issuance of the requested license:

1. The statements contained in this Application for a Special Class "C" One Day License are true and correct.
2. All persons must be 21 years of age, or older, to purchase or be served alcoholic beverages, and be at least 18 years of age to serve them.
3. The preferred types of identification that the Board of License Commissioners have approved to prove age are:
 - a. a Maryland Driver's License
 - b. a Maryland State ID Card
 - c. a Military ID Card
 - d. a Passport or a Permanent Resident's Green Card
4. All sales must stop before midnight.
5. No intoxicated person may be sold or served an alcoholic beverage.
6. No unnecessary noise or disturbance that could be a nuisance to the neighborhood where the event is being held will be permitted.
7. The club, society, or association sponsoring the event will maintain order and decorum at all times.
8. If, in the Board's discretion, the event is a threat to the health, peace, and safety of the neighborhood where the event will be or is being held, this application will be denied or revoked.
9. If in the Board's discretion, the club, society, or association abuses the privilege of having a license, or has requested an inordinate number, the license may be denied.
10. Failure to comply with the laws of the State of Maryland and Rules and Regulations of the Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County may make the responsible person or persons subject to a fine or arrest.
11. The issuance of the requested license is for use only at the event shown on the application.
12. The Board has recommended that there be an alcohol awareness trained person on the premises of the event at all times.
