To the Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County:

Application is hereby made by the undersigned licensee(s) under the provisions of Article 2B, § 8-205, of the Annotated code of Maryland, for a Permit to fill and refill containers, (Growlers) and to sell the "Growlers" to enable the purchaser to consume the beer in the refillable container **off** of the licensed premises. The Board may issue a refillable container Permit to a holder of a Class A License, a Class B License or a Class D License. This entitles the holder of the permit to sell draft beer in Growlers, being refillable containers, with a capacity of not less than 32 ounces and not more than 128 ounces.

To be used as a refillable container, under the previous paragraph, a container shall;

- a.) Be sealable;
- b.) Be branded with the identifying mark of the Permit holder who sells/sold the container.
- c.) Bear the federal health warning statement required for containers of alcoholic beverages under 27 C.F.R. 16.21
- d.) Display instructions for cleaning the container
- e.) Bear a label stating that;
  - i) Cleaning the container is the responsibility of the consumer
  - ii) Contents of the container are perishable and should be refrigerated immediately and consumed within 48 hours after purchase

The applicant(s) shall;

- a.) Complete this Application and
- b.) Pay the annual permit fee of \$500 for an applicant who's alcoholic beverage license **does not** have an off-sale privilege;
- c.) Or pay an additional annual fee of \$50 for an applicant who's alcoholic beverage License **has** an off-sale privilege;

Applicant(s) who hold a license without an off-sale privilege shall meet the same advertising, posting-of-notice, and public hearing requirements as those for the license that the applicant holds.

The term of a refillable container Permit issued to a successful applicant is the same as that of the license that the applicant holds.

The hours of sale for a refillable container Permit;

- a) Begin at the same time as those for the license already held by the licensee(s) to whom the refillable container permit is issued;
- b) End at midnight

A Permit holder may refill only a refillable container that was branded by a Permit holder.
