

PERTAINING TO THE SIXTH AMENDMENT OF THE CALVERT COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT PENSION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland (the "County"), approved Ordinance No. 50-10 which adopted the Calvert County Sheriff's Department Pension Plan (the "Plan"), as amended and restated effective as of July 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to amend the Plan to increase the mandatory retirement age to 62 and to eliminate medical examinations to delay mandatory retirement; and

WHEREAS, Section 14.1 of the Plan authorizes the County to amend the Plan from time to time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, that, effective upon recordation and publication of a fair summary of this Ordinance, the Plan be amended and hereby is amended by deleting Section 6.3 in its entirety and substituting the following new Section 6.3 in its place:

6.3 Retirement shall be mandatory at age 62 for every Member.
