

PERTAINING TO THE APPLICATION FOR A MARYLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CONTINUATION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALVERT COUNTY, MARYLAND, FOR FUNDING TO ASSIST IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOOD DISTRIBUTION CENTER WAREHOUSE LOCATED AT 6021 SOLOMONS ISLAND ROAD, HUNTINGTOWN

WHEREAS, State of Maryland, through the Department of Housing and Community Development (“DHCD”), has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community Development Block Grant Program;

WHEREAS, Calvert County is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland Community Development Block Grant program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners understand and acknowledge that they would be responsible for completion of grant activities and any corrective actions including the repayment of funds if necessary;

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding the application to DHCD for funding under the CDBG program to further assist in the construction of End Hunger in Calvert County Warehouse was duly advertised for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing held on October 5, 2021, at which time the Board of County Commissioners received public comment; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the comments of the public and staff, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County, Maryland, to approve the application to DHCD for funding under the CDBG program to further assist in the construction of End Hunger in Calvert County Warehouse.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners approve and authorize the submittal of an application for Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of Five Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$565,000) for the continuation of project MD-20-CD-21: End Hunger in Calvert County Warehouse;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the President of the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of the application;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that in the event any portion of this Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, null or void, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to sever only the invalid portion or provisions, and that the remainder of this Resolution shall be enforceable and valid;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation without publication of a fair summary.






