Calvert C.A.R.E.S., Inc.

Many offenders are driven to crime to support addictive behavior. A cycle of dependency, criminal activity and incarceration is created. To break this cycle, alternative approaches to treatment and incarceration have been developed. Avoiding people, places and things associated with addiction is the best tool for lasting sobriety.

Using this approach, the Calvert County Adult Treatment Court (ATC) offers participants the opportunity to free themselves from the cycle of addiction and to avoid incarceration. Adults participating in the ATC work toward achieving personal responsibility and productive citizenship. Calvert C.A.R.E.S. supports participants by assisting with educational, medical, vocational and housing needs. The ATC partners with Farming 4 Hunger, a local program providing food for people in Southern Maryland. Each participant volunteers 24 hours of community service to Farming 4 Hunger as a means of giving back to the community.

Department of Social Services

Abused, neglected and troubled Calvert County children are served by various programs offered by the Department of Social Services (DSS). Every year children are assisted by the Department of Social Services, but many needs go unmet. The DSS provides many services and activities that enrich children's lives, increase confidence and provide them with a happy experience during a troubled time.
