

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE APPROVAL OF BUDGET ADJUSTMENT #BA 111

WHEREAS, Title 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County, Maryland, being Title 5 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Laws of Maryland (hereinafter, the “Code”), authorizes and empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland (hereinafter, the “Board of County Commissioners”) to adopt the Annual Budget and Appropriation Act each year;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority pursuant to Section 5-103 of the Code to enact certain budgetary adjustments by Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised that the Calvert County Sheriff’s Office has received a License Plate Reader Grant in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$199,973.00) from the Maryland State Police;

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding this Budget Adjustment #BA 111 was duly advertised in two County newspapers for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing as required by Section 5-103 of the Code and held on January 10, 2023 at which time the Board of County Commissioners received public comment; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the comments of staff and the public, and in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare, the Board of County Commissioners find that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County, Maryland, to amend the operating and grants budget as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, hereby approves and enacts the appropriations and expenditures set forth in Budget Adjustment #BA 111, in the total amount of One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$199,973.00) to reflect award of a License Plate Reader Grant, as reflected in Exhibit A hereto, incorporated by reference and made a part hereof;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that, in the event any portion of this Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, null or void, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to sever only the invalid portion or provision, and that the remainder of the Resolution shall be enforceable and valid;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation without publication of a fair summary.
