

# 2023 Child Care Support Initiatives



Calvert County Family Network (CCFN) allocated **\$94,000 in state grant funds** to support local childcare providers.



CCFN provided **\$5,000** for the annual **Calvert County Family Daycare Conference**. There were 99 attendees.

**19 providers** participated in “**Chalk the Walk**” for **Children’s Mental Health Awareness Week** in May.

CCFN issued **\$51,000** in grants to 15 childcare providers to fund projects and activities that enrich their programs.

CCFN donated **755 books.**

CCFN provided **5276.5 hours** of training to **173 childcare providers.**

CCFN donated **138 giveaways.**

CCFN covered membership fees for **22 childcare centers** to join the Maryland State Childcare Association.

CCFN partnered with the **College of Southern Maryland’s WorkForce Center** to host a Human Resources course for child care center owners and directors.

CCFN developed **credentialing resources** to help providers advance in the Maryland EXCELS program.
