



## Breezy Point Daily Campground Rules

**PETS:** Pets are allowed within the campground side **ONLY**. The owner must keep the animal on a leash at all times while on Breezy Point Beach and Campground property. Campers must clean up animal waste. Campers and their guests may be subject to a \$25 per occurrence fine for not cleaning up animal waste.

**SMOKING/VAPING:** Smoking and vaping are **PROHIBITED** in the park.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Cancellations must be made at least 72 hours in advance of the reservation start date in order to receive a refund, minus a \$5 cancellation fee. Refunds will not be made for "No Shows", inclement weather, or early departures.

**KEY DEPOSIT:** \$20.00 (Cash Only)/ Per key (up to 2 keys per site) deposit fee is collected at Check-In. The key is required to exit and enter the Park after closing. The key(s) deposit fee will be refunded at Check-Out upon the return of key(s) and campsite cleared of all property and trash.

**CAMPING UNITS ALLOWED PER CAMPSITE:** One (1) RV; One (1) RV and one (1) tent; or two (2) tents. Screened tents and shade canopies are included. Overnight sleeping on the beach between the campsite fence and water are not permitted.

**There is a limit of 6 people per campsite, including guests. Additional guests/visitors that exceed the 6 person limit must pay the daily admission fee and are only permitted to be on the public side of the park.**

**VEHICLE PARKING:** Each campsite is **limited to 2 vehicles**. One (1) vehicle is permitted to park on the site and one (1) vehicle in the public parking area (gravel lot). NO parking in the roadways. Violators will be towed at owner's expense and a \$25.00 fee will be charged.

The maximum allowed reservation is 14 days; campers must vacate the park for a minimum of 1 day prior to the next reservation.

**CHECK-IN:** 3:00 - 7:00 PM. Campers must check in by closing or risk forfeiting their reservation. You may call in advance if you know you will arrive late to retain your reservation. Arriving after close may forfeit your first night's stay and require set up site the next day after 9:00 AM. Absolutely NO refunds will be made for forfeited night. Any camper arriving before 3:00 PM check in time will be charged an additional General Admission fee at the Park gate. If you're expected to arrive early and are camping in an RV, please give us a call ahead of time as we may not have parking available.

**CHECK-OUT:** No later than 12:00 PM. Checking out after 12:00 PM will result in an additional day charge.

**TRASH:** All trash **MUST** be removed from your campsite at the end of your reservation. Campers can dispose of their trash in the dumpsters located next to the bathhouse. Any failure to properly dispose of trash is subject to a \$50 fine charged for the first infraction and a \$100 fine for each additional infraction.

**PETS:** Pets are permitted within the campground side **ONLY**. Pets must be registered with the office. The owner **MUST** keep the animal on a leash at all times while on the property as well as clean up all animal waste. Campers and their guests may be subject to a \$25 per occurrence fine for not cleaning up animal waste.

- **Quiet hours: 10:00 PM - 7:00 AM**
- **No utility trailers, boats, golf carts, or scooters are allowed in the Park.**
- No lifeguards on duty. Swim at your own risk. Swimming is permitted in designated areas only.
- No amplified music is allowed in beach, picnic, or campground areas.
- Alcohol is permitted at your campsite. No glass containers.
- Underage drinking, use of illegal drugs, or excessive use of alcoholic beverages will result in immediate removal by local authorities.
- Campers are responsible for the behavior of their children and guests at all times.
- A responsible adult must accompany and actively supervise children under the age of 18.
- Keep off wooden or stone groin structures. Do not remove stones from the stone groins.
- Fishing and crabbing is permitted on the designated fishing pier with appropriate license.
- The following are prohibited: firearms; fireworks of any kind; driving on the beach; inappropriate language and/or abusive profanity; inappropriate behavior, drunkenness, disorderly conduct, indecent exposure; any act committed in violation of the law. Violations will result in immediate ejection from the Park. No refunds will be given.
- Report any damages of property or campsite to the Park office. Campers are encouraged to contact local authorities for personal property damages.
- All persons and property must be able to evacuate the Park within 24 hours of notice of evacuation due to hurricane, severe storms or storm surge. No refunds will be given for time lost due to evacuations.

Breezy Point Beach and Campground reserves the right to terminate reservations at any time, immediately and without refund from disorder, intoxication, or noncompliance with any of the Park rules and regulations and the provisions of the rules stated, resulting in expulsion from the property.
