

KINGS LANDING PARK PRIMITIVE CABIN REGULATIONS



Youth Group or Educational Camping Only:

Individuals and families are not permitted to use the cabin facilities at Kings Landing Park. Youth Groups are defined as registered organizations of youths under 18 with adult chaperones. Educational/Service Groups are registered organizations of primarily adults over 18.

Fees (per cabin, per night): Fees are due in full 31 days from the day of booking.

- Youth Groups: \$25
- Educational/Service Groups: \$50

*Max capacity is 10 campers per cabin.

*Cocktown Creek has 4 cabins available. Mohawk Hill has 3 cabins available.

*Refunds will not be provided due to low attendance. You must calculate the appropriate attendance in advance.

Reservations: Advance reservations are required. Contact Kings Landing Park at 410-535-2661 for date and site availability.

**Reservations for any night other than Friday or Saturday require special permission from the Park Manager.*

Cancellations: Cancellations made at least 15 days prior to the reservation start date will receive a full refund less the prevailing administrative fee.

Bathrooms and Water: Available April 1 - October 30. Port-a-Johns must be rented (by your group) if camping in winter.

Vehicle Parking: Vehicles must park in designated areas only. No parking on roadways or in non-designated fields. Violators will be towed at owner's expense, and event risks ejection from the park.

Check In: An adult representative of the group must check in at least 1 hour prior to park closing to receive cabin keys & review rules with park staff or risk forfeiting their reservation.

**Park Hours are: Memorial Day-Labor Day 9am - 6pm weekdays, 9am - 8pm weekends. Other times of year: 9am - 5pm.*

Check Out: No later than 3:00 pm on the last day of your reservation. Staff will conduct a mandatory walkthrough of the site with a group representative at the conclusion of event.

Keys: Groups will receive 1 key per cabin at check-in. Keys must be returned to staff at check-out. Group may be charged the cost of replacement if any keys are not returned.

Front Gate: The camper lock is the square combination lock. Feel free to give out the combination to responsible parties.

- Both swinging gates and lock must be secured during park's closed hours unless being actively monitored by a responsible adult.
- Do not "dummy lock" (leave the lock unlocked but attached to the chain) the front gate.
- Failure to follow gate rules may result in ejection from the park.

Rules and Regulations for Cabin Use:

- Your group is expected to know and follow all park rules, including those not listed here
 - *This is not a complete set of park rules and regulations. Please refer to the sheet provided with the confirmation form.*
- Quiet Hours: 10:00 pm - 7:00 am
- NO utility vehicles, golf carts, or scooters are allowed within the park.
- Use of the pool is NOT included in your cabin fee.
- Alcohol is NOT permitted.
- A responsible adult must actively supervise children under 16.
- Campfires are allowed at designated fire-pits only and must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- The following are among the prohibited items or activities: firearms, fireworks of any kind, rockets, model airplanes, balloons (including water balloons), silly string, moon-bounces, drones, metal-detecting.
- All trash must be picked up and removed to the dumpster before check-out.
- Please respect nature - do not disturb animals or cut any live wood in the park.
