


KINGS LANDING PARK CAMP FIELD & PAVILION 2 REGULATIONS



Youth Group Camping Only: Individuals and families are not permitted to use the camping facilities at Kings Landing Park. Youth Groups are defined as registered organizations of youths under 18 with adult chaperones.

Fees: A \$50 nonrefundable reservation fee is required for all events and must be paid within 14 days of booking. In addition, the following fees which must be paid 31 days from the day of booking:

- \$0 for 1-50 campers
- \$40 for 51-100 campers
- \$70 for 101-150 campers
- \$100 for 151-200 campers

*Max capacity is 200 campers.

*Refunds will not be provided due to low attendance. You must calculate the appropriate attendance in advance.

Day Camps: Multi-day camps with no overnight are allotted use of one pavilion, with option to reserve Wisner Hall at additional cost. Day Camps will not be permitted after-hours access to the park. All other rules & regulations apply. The fees are as follows:

- \$1.00 per child, per day
- Wisner Hall: \$500 for duration of camp

Reservations: Advance reservations are required. Contact Kings Landing Park at 410-535-2661 for date and site availability.

**Reservations for any night other than Friday or Saturday require special permission from the Park Manager.*

Cancellations: Cancellations made at least 15 days from the reservation start date will receive a full refund less the prevailing administrative fee.

Bathrooms and Water: Available April 1 - October 30. Port-a-Johns must be rented (by your group) for events in winter. Port-a-Johns must also be rented by groups over 75 people due to the size of our septic system. Water hydrants function year-round.

Vehicle Parking: Vehicles must park in designated areas only. No parking on roadways or in non-designated fields. Violators will be towed at owner's expense, and event risks ejection from the park.

Check In: An adult representative of the group must check in upon arrival to review rules with park staff.

Check In: An adult representative of the group must check in at least ½ hour prior to park closing to review rules with park staff or risk forfeiting their reservation. NO refund will be made for groups who arrive after closing.

**Park Hours are: Memorial Day-Labor Day 9am - 6pm weekdays, 9am - 8pm weekends. Other times of year: 9am - 5pm.*

Check Out: No later than 3:00 pm on the last day of your reservation.

Front Gate: The camper lock is the square combination lock. Feel free to give out the combination to responsible parties.

- Both gates and the lock must be secured during park's closed hours unless being actively monitored by a responsible adult.
- Do not "dummy lock" (leave the lock unlocked but attached to the chain) the front gate.
- Failure to follow gate rules may result in ejection from the park.

Rules and Regulations for Equestrian Ring Use:

- Your group is expected to know and follow all park rules, including those not listed here
 - *This is not a complete set of park rules and regulations. Please refer to the sheet provided with the confirmation form.*
- NO utility vehicles, golf carts, or scooters are allowed within the park.
- Use of the pool is NOT included in your camping fee.
- Alcohol is NOT permitted.
- A responsible adult must actively supervise children under 16.
- Fires are allowed at designated fire-pits or in the picnic grills only and must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- The following are among the prohibited items or activities: firearms, fireworks of any kind, rockets, model airplanes, balloons (including water balloons), silly string, moon-bounces, drones, metal-detecting, digging cat-holes.
- All trash must be picked up and removed to the dumpster before check-out.
- All horse manure must be removed from the ring, fields & trails.
- Please respect nature - do not disturb animals or cut any live wood in the park.

Calvert County Natural Resources Division reserves the right to terminate privileges granted at any time, immediately and without refund for non-compliance with park rules and the provisions of these policies.
