


# KINGS LANDING PARK PAVILION 1 REGULATIONS



**Private Events Only:** Events must be by invitation only - no publicly advertised events allowed.

**Fees:**

- \$175 per day (no hourly reservations available) - Due in full 31 days from the day of booking
  - Minimum \$25 down payment due at time of booking

\*The maximum capacity for the pavilion is 100 people.

\*Bathrooms are available year-round.

**Reservations:** Advance reservations are required. Contact Kings Landing Park at 410-535-2661 for date and site availability.

\* *The pavilion is available only during regular park hours. Park Hours are: Memorial Day-Labor Day, weekdays 9 am-6 pm and weekends 9 am-8 pm. Other times of year: 9 am-5 pm.*

**Cancellations:** Cancellations must be made at least 15 days in advance of reservation start date in order to receive a refund. The prevailing administrative fee applies to all refunds.

**Trash:** You are responsible for emptying the trash can and taking all trash to the dumpster at the conclusion of your event. Staff will provide extra trash bags if needed.

**Alcohol:** No alcohol is permitted at pavilions.

**Vehicle Parking:** Vehicles may park in front of the barn and in designated spaces, with overflow at the trailhead across the road or adjacent to Wisner Hall. Parking vehicles in non-designated fields, on the road or anywhere beyond the barn is NOT allowed. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense, and event risks ejection from the park.

**Vendors & Grills:** Charcoal grills are allowed if park staff are notified ahead of time. Your event may be catered. For any other cooking apparatus (propane grill, camp stove, etc.) or vendor (food/ice truck, game services, etc.), a Special Request form must be submitted. Speak to Park Manager for details.

**Check In:** An adult representative must check in with park staff upon arrival.

**Allowed:**

- Pop up tents
- Camp chairs, folding tables
- Use of nearby fire pit
- Field games that do not mar the landscape, e.g.:
  - Volleyball/Badminton nets are OK.
  - Digging a horseshoe pit is NOT OK.

**Prohibited:**

- Moon Bounces/inflatables
- Balloons (including water balloons). They are a danger to wildlife.
- Confetti of any kind (including sequins, glitter)
- Firearms or fireworks of any kind
- Rockets, model airplanes, or drones

**Rules and Regulations for Pavilion Use:**

- Your group is expected to know and follow all park rules, including those not listed here
  - *This is not a complete set of park rules and regulations. Please refer to the sheet provided with the confirmation form.*
- NO utility vehicles, golf carts, or scooters are allowed within the park.
- Use of the pool is NOT included in your fee.
- A responsible adult must actively supervise children under 16.
- Campfires are allowed at designated fire-pits only and must be supervised at all times by an adult over the age of 18.
- Fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas with appropriate licenses.
- Please respect nature - do not disturb animals or cut any live wood in the park.
