This includes submitting required documents and registering your child in their designated home school based on your residence address. Homeschooling in Calvert County: If you choose to homeschool your children, you'll need to complete a Home Instruction Notification Form and submit it at least 15 days before starting your homeschooling program. TRICARE Prime Remote (TPR) provides health care for active-duty service members, activated National Guard and Reserve members, and their families living in remote areas. TPR offers access to a Primary Care Manager (PCM) for routine care, manages referrals and authorizations for specialty services, and does not require enrollment fees, deductibles, or cost-shares. Eligible members can also get travel expense reimbursements for medical appointments through the Prime Travel Benefit.
