Subject: Tree Debris Disposal from Extreme Weather Event

FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDRESSING PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE CONCERNS AND STORM DEBRIS

WHEREAS, Friday, May 16, 2025, Calvert County experienced severe winds, and rain that caused trees to be uprooted or felled, power outages and disruption of services in Calvert County;

WHEREAS, the conditions that exist beyond the passage of that storm create life-threatening conditions throughout Calvert County, including the increased risk of the spread of fire and impediments to the passage of emergency equipment;

WHEREAS, the removal of storm debris is necessary to preserve community health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County wishes to ratify the opening of the Appeal Landfill for tree debris, including limbs, branches and logs no larger than 5 feet in length, at no charge to residents of Calvert County to mitigate the increased risk of the spread of fire and impediments to the passage of emergency equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County that the tipping fee for tree debris, including limbs, branches and logs no larger than 5 feet in length, related to the storm will be waived for the residents of Calvert County through Saturday, May 24, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be retroactively effective May 17, 2025.




