RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE OPIOID LITIGATION FUND AND APPROVAL OF BUDGET ADJUSTMENT BA2026-000528

WHEREAS, Title 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County, Maryland, being Title 5 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Laws of Maryland (hereinafter, the "Code"), authorizes and empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland (hereinafter, the "Board of County Commissioners") to adopt the Annual Budget and Appropriation Act each year;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority pursuant to Section 5-103 of the Code to enact certain budgetary adjustments by Resolution;

WHEREAS, Calvert County has been significantly impacted by the opioid epidemic, resulting in increased rates of substance use disorder, overdose, and associated public health, public safety, and social service costs;

WHEREAS, the county has received, and is anticipated to continue to receive, settlement proceeds arising from national opioid litigation involving opioid manufacturers, distributors, and related entities;

WHEREAS, such settlement proceeds are intended to be used solely for opioid remediation purposes, consistent with the terms of the state settlement agreement and applicable state law;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County has established a dedicated fund to ensure transparency, accountability, and appropriate use of opioid litigation proceeds for evidence-based strategies to prevent, treat, and mitigate opioid use disorder and its impacts;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Community Resources that there is a need to budget \$154,500 in Calvert County's Opioid Litigation Fund in fiscal year 2026 to support opioid restitution fund grant activities;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Community Resources and the Department of Finance and Budget that funds totaling \$154,500 are available in the Opioid Litigation Fund account;

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding this Budget Adjustment BA2026-000528 was duly advertised in two County newspapers for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing as required by Section 5-103(c) of the Code and held on Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at which time the Board of County Commissioners received public comment; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the comments of the public and staff and in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County, Maryland to amend the adopted FY2026 Budget as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland hereby approves and enacts the increase of appropriations and expenditures set forth in Budget Amendment #BA2026-000528 in the total amount of One Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$154,000) as reflected in Exhibit A hereto, incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, that, in the event any portion of this Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, null or void, by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to sever only the invalid portion or provision, and that the remainder of the Resolution shall be enforceable and valid, unless deletion of the invalid portion would defeat the clear purpose of the Resolution, or unless deletion of the valid portion would produce a result inconsistent with the purpose and intent of the Board of County Commissioners in enacting this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation.
