In the 2014 session of the Maryland General Assembly a Bill was passed to prohibit the consumption of alcoholic beverages in Calvert County businesses that do not hold a license to sell alcohol. This means that such businesses may not furnish alcohol to patrons or allow them to bring their own alcohol into a business to consume it on the business premises. The Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County want all business owners and their patrons to be aware of this change in the law which will be effective July 1, 2014 because the potential maximum penalty for violating it is a fine of up to \$10,000 and/or two years imprisonment. This is Chapter 292 of the Laws of 2014.
