

**A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
DETENTION CENTER WEEKENDER FEES AND APPROVAL OF BUDGET
ADJUSTMENT #BA268**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Section 11-801 of the annotated code of Maryland has the authority to impose on and collect from a weekend inmate a reasonable fee;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Sheriff of Calvert County has implemented Policy Section 250, Weekend Inmates, to allow an inmate to remain employed while he pays his debt to society;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Department of Finance and Budget that this fee would generate approximately \$43,000 in additional revenues for the remainder of FY 2015;

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding this Fee Adoption and Budget Adjustment #BA268 was duly advertised in two County newspapers for two consecutive weeks before the public hearing as required by Section 5-103(c) of the Code and held on December 9, 2014, at which time the Board of County Commissioners received public comment; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the comments of the public and staff and in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare, the Board of County Commissioners find that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County, Maryland, to amend the operating budgets as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, hereby Adopts a Weekend Inmate fee of \$55 and approves and enacts the appropriations and expenditures set forth in Budget Adjustment #BA268, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, in the total amount of \$43,000 to provide the FY 2015 operating funding to provide additional funding for inmate health insurance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that, in the event any portion of this Resolution is found to be unconstitutional, illegal, null or void, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to sever only the invalid portion or provision, and that the remainder of the Resolution shall be enforceable and valid.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation without publication of a fair summary.
